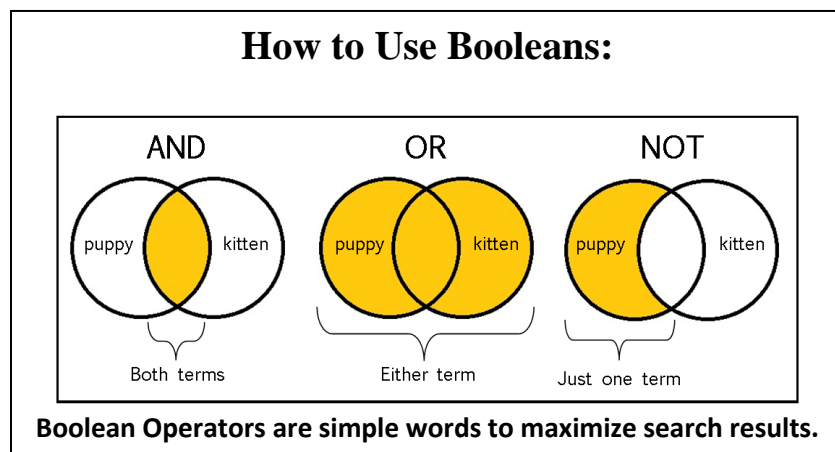

- **[Atlanta Daily World \(1931-2003\)](#)** The Atlanta Daily World had the first black White House correspondent and was the first black daily in the nation in the 20th century.
- **[The Baltimore Afro-American \(1893-1988\)](#)** was the most widely circulated black newspaper on the Atlantic coast.
- **[Chicago Defender \(1910-1975\)](#)** A leading African-American newspaper, with more than two-thirds of its readership outside Chicago.
- **[Cleveland Call and Post \(1934-1991\)](#)** was founded by Garrett Morgan, inventor of the gas mask and traffic light.
- **[Los Angeles Sentinel \(1934-2005\)](#)** is the oldest and largest black newspaper in the western United States and the largest African-American owned newspaper in the U.S.
- **[New York Amsterdam News \(1922-1993\)](#)** This leading Black newspaper of the 20th century reached its peak in the 1940s.
- **[The Norfolk Journal and Guide \(1921-2003\)](#)** was one of the best researched and well written black newspapers of its time.
- **[The Philadelphia Tribune \(1912-2001\)](#)** the oldest continuously published black newspaper.
- **[Pittsburgh Courier \(1911-2002\)](#)** was one of the most nationally circulated Black newspapers.
